
#### **Mandates**

# Pennsylvania Rural and Urban Counties, 2020




#### Statewide Population Density = 291 Persons per Square Land Mile, 2020


19 Urban Counties - Population Density At or Above Statewide Rate

48 Rural Counties - Population Density Below Statewide Rate


# **Current Landscape of Dental Providers in Pennsylvania**



### Total Number of Dentists with a National Provider Identifier (NPI) by County, 2023




#### Statewide Total = 9,402 Dentists with an NPI




Note: The NPI is a unique identifier developed by CMS. Covered health care providers and all health plans and health care clearinghouses must use the NPIs in the administrative and financial transactions adopted under HIPAA. A dentist is a person qualified by a doctorate in dental surgery (D.D.S.) or dental medicine (D.M.D.), licensed by the state to practice dentistry, and practicing within the scope of that license. There is no difference between the two degrees: dentists who have a DMD or DDS have the same education.








Note: Total Professionally Active includes dentists whose primary occupation is dental related. This includes the fields Total Full-time and Total Part-time Private Practice; Dental School Faculty; Armed Forces; Other Federal Service; State or Local Government; Hospital Staff Dentist; Graduate Student/Resident; Other Health/Dental Organization Staff; and Part-Time Faculty/Part-Time Practice. Only those identified as active and licensed are included.




#### Statewide Total = 6,648 Dentists Working in Private Practice

- 100+ Dentists in Private Practice


91% of Dentists in Pennsylvania Work in Private Practice








### Ages of Active Dentists in Pennsylvania, 2022

Urban




# Designated Health Professional Shortage Areas – Dental Care

# Health Professional Shortage Area Definition

A Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) is a geographic area, population group, or health care facility that has been designated by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) as having a shortage of health professionals. There are three categories of HPSAs: 1. Primary Care 2. Dental Health 3. Mental Health


Type of HPSA	Definition
Geographic HPSA	A shortage of providers for an entire group of people within a defined geographic area
Population HPSA	A shortage of providers for a specific group of people within a defined geographic area. Examples include low-income populations, homeless populations, and migrant farmworker populations.
Facility HPSA	Correctional Facility, State/County Mental Hospital, FQHCs, FQHCs Look-Alikes, Certified Rural Health Clinics, etc.



Statewide Designated Dental Health HPSAs = 48 HPSA Population
