Here are the topics I intend on addressing:

- Continued Sales Decline especially from comparative year 2019 (we were down 33% in January and February alone vs 2020)
 - People are still hesitant to go to restaurants
- Commodity and supply price increases
 - They aren't subsidizing. Much of it is increasing. Hurting us in rural areas significantly due to price sensitivity of low to moderate income populations
 - Gloves from \$40/case to \$120/case
 - One time use items and associated costs
 - Together Cost of Goods and Supplies increases are nearly 6% vs 2019 overall
 - Accompanied by a proposed increase in minimum wage would be a death sentence
- Staffing and the inability of many to fill employment needs
- Unemployment rates for insurance and employers having to eat the increases (significant increases)
- Businesses that were planned for 2020 and followed through with and the lack of financial support these businesses are eligible for
